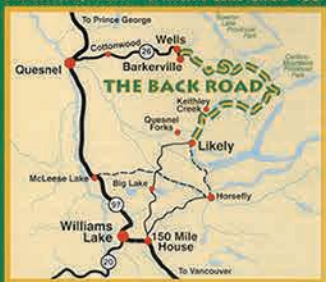


The Back Road Portion of the
Barkerville/Wells – Williams Lake Circle Tour



The back road linking Likely and Wells/Barkerville is the wilderness portion of a Circle Tour that takes you on paved highways from Williams Lake to Wells/Barkerville. You will then travel through the Cariboo Mountains to Likely on a well maintained gravel road where a paved road takes you back to Williams Lake and Highway #97.

The back road is seasonal, open from June to October (depending on the snow pack), and takes about 3½ hours allowing for stops along the way. Food and sufficient gas in your vehicle are recommended. Included in this brochure is an area map with site indicators, detailed road instructions covering landmark and overviews of the highlights.

Distances are approximate but within a quarter of a kilometre in accuracy. The road summit is close to 1,219 metres (4,000 feet), and mountain views are over 2,133 metres (7,000 feet).

This is a delightful journey through dramatic scenery with many opportunities to view wildlife and relax in pleasant well appointed picnic settings.
